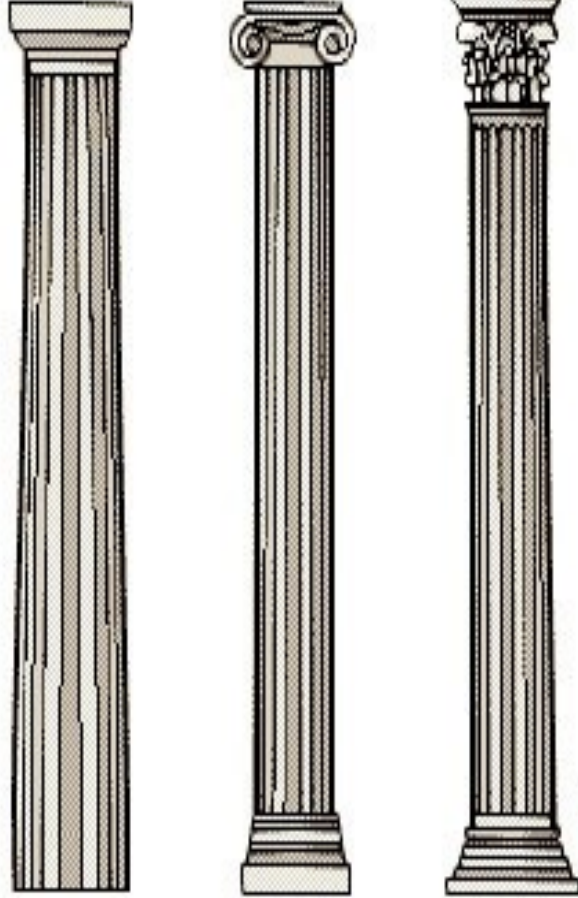

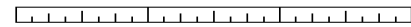

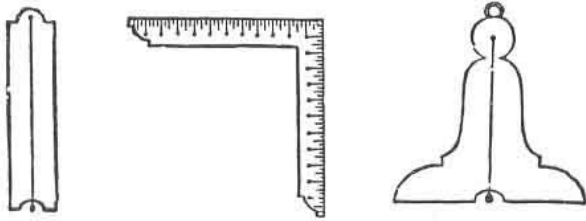
# September, 2017 Trestleboard
