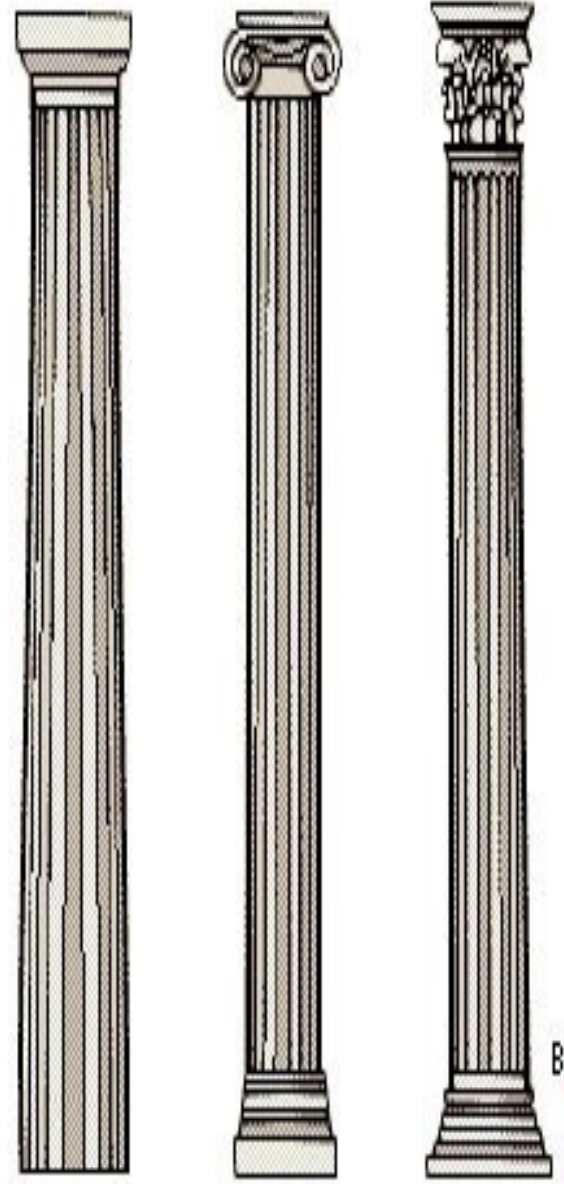

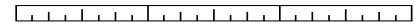

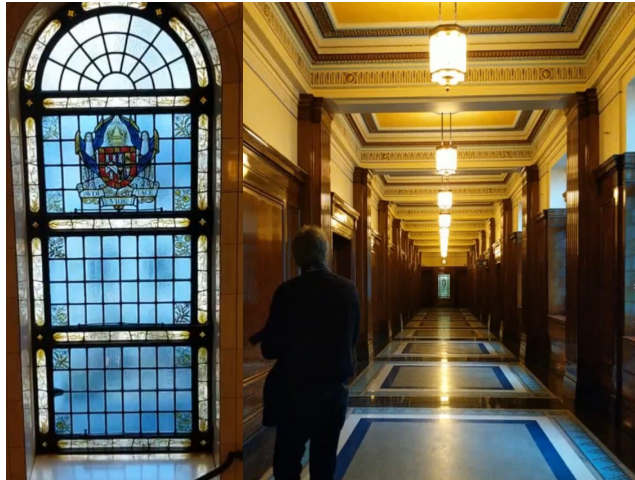

After this stated communication, our lodge "goes dark". Which really just means we have ceased to have Stated Meetings for an agreed upon period of time, in our specific case until September 14th. This tradition extends from farming communities wherein when a large number of the lodge's members are farmers and must tend to their crops during the Summer; it is agreed that the lodge should "go dark" until Fall when their crops have been harvested.

This also applies to other trades and livelihoods such as if a large number of the lodge's members are fishermen and are at sea for periods of time or military lodges whose members are deployed.

As with everything in Masonry, this all depends on jurisdiction. Some lodges "go dark" for a period of time each year. Some lodges choose not to "go dark" during any period of time during the year.
