GRAND MASTER PRESENTS 70-YEAR CERTIFICATE

On Saturday, September 7, 2019 M.W. Donald E. Rosenberry, Grand Master of Masons in Delaware and Kevin O'Rourke, Worshipful Master of Eureka DuPont Lodge presented Brother McDaniel his certificate honoring his 70 years of membership in Eureka and subsequently Eureka-DuPont Lodge.

In January 2019 at the Grand Visitation to Eureka-DuPont No. 23-29, M.W. Rosenberry, had planned to present Brother Richard "Dick" McDaniel his 70 year membership certificate. Unfortunately, Brother McDaniel was too infirm to attend. At the request of Brother McDaniel's daughter, Amy, Eureka-DuPont was able to reschedule at Brother McDaniel's home in North East, Maryland. Grand Marshal Clinton Robertson, Aide to the Grand Master, Sam Katz, WM James Hanby (Washington No. 1), Bro. Tim Jackson (Eureka-DuPont), Bro. Ruben Argudo (Union Lodge No. 48 Elkton), Bro. McDaniel's son-in-law, and WM Tyler Bazzoli (Brandywine No. 33), Bro. McDaniel's granddaughter's husband, were there to support the presentation.

Brother McDaniel, now in his nineties, joined Masonry when he was 24. Many of his family, including his wife, Marina, daughter, Amy and others also joined in the celebration of this great milestone in his Masonic history. It was later learned that after the presentation team departed and things calmed a bit, Brother McDaniel fondly reminisced about his days in Masonry.

When Brother McDaniel joined Eureka Lodge in 1949, the Worshipful Master was James F. Hearn, who served as Master from June 1948 to June 1949. On June 4, 1949, Bro. Hearn was elected Mayor of Wilmington. He was sworn in July 1, 1949 by Hon. Thomas Herlihy, Jr., another Brother of Eureka Lodge.

In December of 1949, one wonders if Brother McDaniel was one of the 250 lodge members who gathered to welcome Mayor Hearn and United States Senator and M.W. Grand Master J. Allen Frear, Jr. as Grand Master Frear paid Eureka Lodge an official visit.

This, Brothers, is what Masonry is all about, a fraternity that is always there for its Brethren and the Brethren always there for the fraternity.
